Thursday highlights: Relationship-rich education and an exclusive Q&A with Joseph Renzulli

Tomorrow, we have another varied program prepared for you. The day kicks off with parallel sessions, followed at 10.45 by an in-depth session on 'Relationship-Rich Education: How human connections drive success in college', by American professors Leo Lambert & Peter Felten. They first discuss their views in an online panel, and then join for a live Q&A. In the afternoon there is variety of sessions on offer, including sessions in which students and teachers from host institution Hanze University of Applied Sciences present themselves and their projects. At 17.30, a live Q&A session with professor Joseph Renzulli from the US is hosted. Finally, Amy Vollmer will discuss the honors program at Swarthmore College, where honors education was 'invented' almost a century ago.

Additional suggestion would be to avoid running any heavy applications while accessing the online platform. Finally, if you are presented with a blank screen while in a session, try refreshing your browser using the refresh button or f5.
